Limerick Institute of Technology (LIT) was founded in 1852 – making it one of the oldest Institutes of Technology in Ireland. LIT is a multi-campus, public government funded, higher education institution based in the Mid-West of Ireland, with an enrolment of around 7,000 students. LIT offers career focused programmes across a wide range of disciplines from Higher Certificate to PhD.

HOW TO APPLY?

LIT APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Decide on your course: A full list of the available courses can be found at www.lit.ie/en-lE/courses
- 2. Complete your application form: The LIT International Application Form can be downloaded from www.lit.ie/international-study/how-to-apply
- 3. Submit Application Form: Send your completed application, along with copies of your academic results and English qualifications by email to international@lit.ie
- 4. Applications for a September start should be made before June 1st. Late applications may be considered.

VISAS:

Students from Visa Required countries should allow sufficient time for visa processing – in some cases up to 12 weeks.

LIT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

FIRST YEAR UNDERGRADUATE:

Applicants must achieve suitable grades in a recognised Secondary Education Examination, (equivalent to A-Levels or IB), in order to satisfy LIT entry requirements. A Portfolio is required for all Art & Design programmes.

ADVANCED ENTRY (ENTRY TO YEAR 2, 3 OR 4 OF AN UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME) & POSTGRADUATE ENTRY:

Applicants must provide:

- Academic Transcripts for all prior education.
- Document showing English Language proficiency.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

LIT SCHOLARSHIPS

A limited number of Merit based President's Scholarships of \le 1000 each are available to international students each year.

Required for consideration in addition to Academic Transcripts:

- $\bullet \ \ Letter \ of \ Recommendation \ (e.g. \ Academic \ supervisor, \ Voluntary \ Work).$
- Personal Statement Letter.

Closing date for entry is June 30th.


