# ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

# INDONESIA

**Postgraduate programme** - achieving Bachelor (Honours) degree with a minimum grade of 2.5 for UK 2:2 and GPA of 3.5 for UK 2:1

**Year 2 & 3** - Some Bachelor's degrees allow advanced entry to year 2 or year 3 depending on your study history. If you are currently pursuing your Bachelor's degree you might be eligible to transfer directly to year 2 or year 3 of our Bachelor degree. ## HOW TO APPLY

You can apply directly to the university via submitting an application free of cost.

When making an application, please complete the form fully and attach all academic transcripts, proof of English language and if required references. When the application form is received the International Office will need to consider your whole profile in order to assess your suitability for the programme for which you have applied.

### Direct entry and transferring

The University of Greenwich welcomes international students to transfer directly into year 2 or 3 for a number of our degree programmes. This allows you to 'top-up' your degree without studying for the three full years in the UK. Students completing top-up degrees can apply for our wide-range of postgraduate programmes.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIRMENTS

Along with meeting the academic entry requirements, you might have to meet the English language requirements depending on your nationality. Our general English language requirement is to achieve an overall IELTS score of 6.5 and 5.5 in each skill.
