Entry Requirements

Undergraduate

A-levels: Applicants are required to offer a minimum of three subjects at A-levels, with many courses requiring an additional fourth subject at AS-level.

IB: Most courses require a minimum of 36 - 38 points for entry, with some courses requiring a minimum number of points for specific subjects.

Please refer to typical entry requirements for each course for full details.

Postgraduate

Most courses (typically in Humanities and Social Sciences) require a GPA of 3.3 and above, although some courses (typically in the Sciences) accept a GPA of 3.0 and above.

English Language

<u>Undergraduate applicants</u> offering A-Levels or IB Diploma may be exempted from SELT. For detailed English Language requirements, please see:

<u>Postgraduate applicants</u> will need to obtain IELTS results as follows (or other SELT equivalent):

- For most courses under the Faculty of Science, as well as Economics: Overall score of 6.5 (no component below 6.0)
- For most courses under the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Social Sciences, as well as Psychology: Overall score of 7.0 (max. 2 components at 6.0/6.5)
- For courses offered by the English Literature Department: Overall score of 7.5 (max. 2 components at 6.5/7.0)

Band 1 courses are classroom-based and include most courses in Humanities and Social Sciences.

Band 2 courses are mainly laboratory-based and include Theatre & Performance Studies, Department of Economics and Warwick Business School degrees and Science courses.
