Scholarships

- Scholarships varying from £3,000 to full scholarship awards (tuition fees and living costs)
- Mainly for postgraduate courses although a small number available for undergraduates. Only offer holders can apply.
- Undergraduate High Achiever Awards (A Level/IB)
- Application deadlines – 29th May for September intake and 13th October for January intake
- Alumni discounts available – 15% off the cost of a Masters degree or PhD (excludes Master of Architecture (MArch) (RIBA pt II) and Architecture Postgraduate Diploma Professional Practice (RIBA Part III).)

- You do not need UKVI IELTS, but you will need an approved English Test (please see our [English Language Requirements](#) page for more information)
- Requirement: Overall = IELTS 5.0 (with 5.0 minimum in writing and 4.5 in all other components)
- 22/06 – 28/08, £3,400 course fee
- Discounted fee of £3,000 if course fees are paid before 7 September 2020
- Apply by contacting presessional@westminster.ac.uk
- Application deadline: 14 September 2020
- Online Pre Sessional can be used for Jan 21 and Sept 21 intakes

Fees and Deposits

Taught Bachelors / Masters Degrees

- £4,000 deposit
- 50% at enrolment
- Remaining 50% can be paid in two further instalments (Dec / Jan*)
(March and April for January start courses)
