Preparatory German Language Courses

The International Office of Chemnitz University of Technology offers preparatory German language courses in cooperation with the Foreign Language Centre.

Degree-seeking students:

Advanced courses for all students planning to take the DSH examination:

PLEASE NOTE: Chemnitz University of Technology does not offer beginners' courses.

- **Content** - based on B2-Level, this course prepares students for the German Language Proficiency Test for University Entrance (DSH).
- **Requirements** - Letter of admission to Chemnitz University of Technology including admission to German language course and a German language certificate at level B2 (Goethe-Institut/telc/DSH-1/ösd/TestDaF level 3 in all 4 examination parts/12-15 points in total)
- **Sessions** - Dates are announced on the website of the International Office:

- **Duration** - 15 weeks, Monday to Friday, 24 to 28 hours/week
- **Fee** - 1500 Euros (including fee for DSH examination, tuition, course materials, mentoring and support)

PLEASE NOTE: The entire course fee has to be transferred prior to the beginning of this course. Banking details will be given after registration via Email.

Application deadlines for enrolment in BA and MA programs at Chemnitz University of Technology:

- Summer term (April to September): **15th January**
- Winter term (October to March): **15th July**

Exchange Students (e.g. Erasmus+):

Intensive course "German language, civilization and culture for exchange students"

- **Content** - Enhancement of oral language proficiency; vocabulary and grammar; academic research skills; reading and listening skills; German culture
- **Levels** - Beginner, intermediate and advanced
- **Sessions** - Dates are announced on the website of the International Office:

- **Duration** - 3 weeks, Monday to Friday, total of 65 hours
- **Fee** - 50 Euros (only for non-Erasmus students)

PhD-students and Postdocs:

Courses offered during the semester (different levels each semester, total of 60 hours)

- **Content** - Introduction to grammar, reading, listening, writing and basic oral skills
- **Sessions** - Dates are announced via Email
- **Duration** - one semester
- **Fee** - free of charge
