
The university in its region

Willingness to cooperate at the Normandy level



- Community of Universities and Institutions known as the "Communauté d'Universités et Établissements" in French or ComUE with "Normandie Université"
- Higher Education Conference of the Rouen Agglomeration or "Conférence de l'Enseignement Supérieur de l'Agglomération de Rouen" (CESAR)
- Close links with the main local authorities: the Normandy Region, the Rouen Normandy Metropolis, Évreux Portes de Normandie, and the Community of Conurbation of Le Havre

Key partners

- Four-year partnership with the city of Mont-Saint-Aignan which hosts the University's headquarters
- Regional structuring of research by integrating the 5 thematic training and research centres of Normandy University
- Partnership with the Charles-Nicolle University Hospital and its involvement in the eponymous Foundation, which enables hospitals from Normandy to benefit from innovative equipment for health research
- Flaubert University Foundation, the university contributes to the animation of the intellectual, cultural and artistic life of the city

- Taking into account new ways of working






PROFESSIONAL INTEGRATION



Supporting students

Encouraging professional integration: the University of Rouen Normandy regularly offers forums where students and employers can meet and exchange ideas.

- Two dedicated services: the Professional Integration Assistance Office (BAIP) and the Observatory of Student Life, Training and Professional Integration (OVEFIP)
- Help in searching for internships and jobs, drawing up a CV or cover letter, preparing for interviews.

- The Centre for Continuing Education and Work-linked Training advises and assists candidates as well as companies in all their procedures.
- Lifelong learning also means alternating study and work, or distance learning to meet individual needs.
