The master's degree Programme Grande École (PGE) is a 2-year program. Taught in English or in French, the program focuses on the practical teaching of international management. Its successful completion leads to an internationally recognized master's degree.

1st year PGE (Master 1)

Consolidate and build on your knowledge of management while refining your managerial culture through business games and case studies.

2nd year PGE (Master 2)

Choose your specialization tailored to Strasbourg's economic setting and region: finance, international and European business, operational and strategic marketing, international wine management and tourism (co-op available).

Otherwise, you can, upon fulfillment of the requirements, opt for the French track: marketing, comptabilité contrôle-finance, management responsable des ressources humaines, supply chain management et achat international, entrepreneuriat, etc.
