Erasmus Mundus MA in Public Policy (Mundus MAPP)

Mundus MAPP is an internationally recognized two-year Master programme in Public Policy. It offers an interdisciplinary curriculum delivered by four outstanding European university institutes: the Central European University (CEU) in Vienna, ISS in The Hague, the Institut Barcelona d'Estudis Internacionals (IBEI) and the University of York (UoY). The first year is spent either at ISS or CEU while the second year is spent either at the UoY or IBEI.


