Student life in Tampere

Our campuses provide services and flexible spaces in three different locations: City Centre, Kauppi and Hervanta. The campuses offer a compact combination of all the services students need. There are several cafes and restaurants offering tasty and affordable student lunches. All campuses have comprehensive sports services, including gyms, group exercise activities, ball games and different courses.

Living costs

All Tampere University Bachelor's and Master's degree students are members of the Student Union. The membership entitles you to various benefits, discounts and services offered directly or indirectly by the Student Union.

Living costs in Finland are on average comparable to most of Europe. For basic living expenses in Tampere, you'll need € 800–1200 per month, depending on your personal spending habits.

Degree students are entitled to use the services of the Finnish Student Health Service (FSHS) and must pay an annual health service fee to Kela (Social Insurance Institution of Finland) for each year as an attending student. The healthcare fee entitles you to general health, dental and mental health services.
